- What films are suitable for kids? Are there any kinds that should be banned to watch by kids?
- Do you think that the fact that a film was awarded an Oscar or Gold Globe is a guarantee of quality? Do you know any other film awards?
- Do film reviews affect your decision to see a certain film? Do you often read reviews?
